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**Amendment No. 1
to the Agreement between
Jacksonville Aviation Authority
and
Siemens Industry, Inc.
for
Fire Protection System Maintenance and Repair Services**

This Amendment No. 1 is made and entered into in duplicate this 10th day of February, 2025, by and between the Jacksonville Aviation Authority, a Florida public body politic and corporate whose address is 14201 Pecan Park Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32218 (the “Authority”) and Siemens Industry, Inc. (“Contractor”), a corporation authorized to do business with the state of Florida, regarding the Agreement by and between the Parties dated January 31, 2024, for Fire Protection System Maintenance and Repair Services (“Agreement”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about January 31, 2024, the Authority entered into an Agreement for Services with the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains a provision that, at the sole discretion of the Authority, permits the Parties to authorize additional work to the Agreement at the prices, rates, fees, percentages, or discounts contained in the Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Authority requested, and the Contractor provided a proposal to provide additional Fire Protection System Maintenance and Repair Services for the Air Cargo 4 Building in accordance with Proposal No. 8695911, **Exhibit A**, hereto and incorporated herein for an accurate description of the maintenance and repair services to be performed.

WHEREAS, based on mutual needs of the Parties, the Parties agree to the additional scope of services and the corresponding compensation as stated in Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES, BASED UPON MUTUAL CONSIDERATION, THE SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH IS ACKNOWLEDGED, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **INCORPORATION OF RECITALS.** The Parties find that the statements set forth in the above recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporate the same as part of this amendment.

2. **SCOPE / CHANGES IN SERVICES.** The Parties agree to include additional Fire Protection System Maintenance and Repair Services as defined in Proposal No. 8695911, **Exhibit A**, for the period February 1, 2025 to September 30, 2028. (The period of retroactivity from February 1, 2025 through date of this amendment is solely for the purpose of connecting the contractual service period and shall not be considered a basis for additional compensation for services that have already been invoiced and paid).
