BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Storeroom, a unit of the Procurement Department, has a continuing need to stock various Janitorial products. Procurement researched this need against various vendors and cooperative purchasing sources and determined it would be in JAA's best interest to piggy-back U.S. Communities contract 17-21 for the replenishment of applicable stock located in JAA's inventory.

Procurement presented award submission AC2017-12-05 Supplyworks US Communities which was subsequently approved for a three-year initial term, November 1, 2017 to October 31, 2020 with an option to renew for two additional one-year periods for a five-year total of \$640,000.00. In October 2019, the cooperative contract was extended through October 31, 2022.

As a result of JAA's response to COVID-19 readiness and related issues, the five-year not to exceed amount of \$640,000.00 has been greatly depleted. As of November 2020, total contract spend was approximately \$555,000.00. To account for this spend and future needs related to both passenger traffic and the continuation of COVID-19, Storeroom and Procurement request an additional \$295,000.00 to cover expected expenses through the end of the contract period on October 31, 2022.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends that JAA Award No. AC2017-12-05 to Home Depot Pro, formerly Supplyworks, for the continual purchase of janitorial supplies, be amended to: (i) add an additional \$295,000.00 to cover expected expenses, for a new total not-to-exceed award amount of \$935,000.00; and (ii) align the award term consistent with the utilized contract, which is currently through October 31, 2022. JAA reserves the right to make future purchases of this commodity from other vendors when it is in JAA's best interest to do so.

BACKGROUND:

The parking toll plaza is the main collection point for parking revenues. Patrons are directed to the proper lane based on lane availability or customer needs by means of digital signs above each lane. The current signs have been in production for over 10 years and are failing due to their age. Parts are no longer available, and the system is generally unsupportable.

JAA utilizes Four Winds Interactive to control content being displayed on all of its digital signs, providing a central point of management, support, and content control.

JAA also utilizes Art of Context's (AoC) proprietary Emergency Messaging System (EMS) to generate emergency messages sent to digital signs. As AoC is the Four Winds authorized reseller for Four Winds license and product, the recommended signs must be installed, configured, and licensed to work on JAA's Four Winds platform. Since JAA is utilizing AoC's EMS system, this award request represents a sole source purchase.

Please note that this purchase will increase JAA's annual cost for Four Winds licenses by an amount of \$1,811.52, which will be contemplated in a separate award. Also, this request includes an additional 5%, or \$5,315.55, for unforeseen circumstances.

RECOMMENDATION:

Information Technology recommends a properly noticed sole source award be made to Art of Context pursuant to section 3.09 of the Procurement Code, for the procurement, configuration, deployment, and turn-up of digital wayfinding signs at the JAA toll plaza in the amount of \$106,291.00, plus an additional 5%, or \$5,315.55, for unforeseen circumstances, for a total not-to-exceed award amount of \$111,605.55.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has been a long-time member of Airports Council International (ACI), the voice of airports in the industry. For the base membership, members can take advantage of many benefits, including participation in all activities, access to first-class tools and resources, and regulatory advocacy. The dues amount is formula-based using an airport's passenger and cargo activity; therefore, it will increase or decrease each year, accordingly.

The membership dues for 2021 are \$63,268.80. Historically, the membership cost has increased 7% per year. As this may be the pattern for future annual increases, Management recommends including an additional 7% per renewal year for potential annual rate increases over the next five years.

RECOMMENDATION:

Management recommends a properly noticed award be made to Airports Council International for Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) membership for fiscal years 2021-2025, for a five-year total amount of \$363,842.40. This purchase is exempt from competition pursuant to section 2.05(A)(8) of JAA's Procurement Code.
