#### BACKGROUND:

On September 21, 2020, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved Award No. AC2020-09-04 to Florida Cleaning Systems for custodial department staff augmentation services at the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). The original award authorized supplemental custodial staff services through March 2021 in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$75,000.00, in addition to the informal award of services of \$25,000.00, for a final not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000.00.

Because of costs directly associated with additional staff necessary for more frequent cleaning and disinfecting requirements, staff augmentation services for the remainder of the fiscal year will exceed the current authorized not-to-exceed amount. As such, Facilities requests authorization to increase the total award amount by \$87,091.20 to cover the costs associated with supplemental custodial staff services

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Facilities recommends JAA Award No. AC2020-09-04, which was awarded to Florida Cleaning Systems, Inc. for custodial staff augmentation services, be amended to: (i) continue services through September 2021; and (ii) include an additional \$87,091.20, for a new total not-to-exceed amount of \$187,091.20. #### BACKGROUND:

On February 27, 2017, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved Award No. AC2017-02-03 for dry carpet cleaning services at the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). JAA utilized National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract No. 121715-MAC, competitively awarded to Milliken and Company. Services have been provided by Cubix, Inc., a State of Florida certified Milliken carpet services dealer, on behalf of Milliken and Company. This contract expired on February 16, 2021.

To avoid a disruption in services, Facilities requests authorization to utilize Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) Contract No. P-20-006 for Carpet Cleaning Services, competitively awarded to Cubix, Inc., to provide Millicare dry carpet cleaning services at JIA. The service locations and proposed annual costs can be summarized as follows:

- 1. Administration Building, ARFF Firehouse and FAA Sector Building: \$11,170.05
- 2. Jacksonville International Airport Terminal Building: \$34,965.94

An additional \$10,000.00 is requested for each year of the contract to cover costs associated with upholstery and extra required cleanings in high traffic areas throughout the airport. The additional funds will increase the annual total award amount to \$56,135.99.

### BACKGROUND:

For the past two years, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Hold-Baggage Screening (HBS) Unit has utilized a contract with Unified Supply for the purchase of baggage carousel, baggage makeup and other related component parts for the belt system at the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). The current contract is set to expire on February 28, 2021.

To avoid an interruption in belt system maintenance and repairs necessary to remain compliant with JAA directives, Facilities requests authorization to enter into a new contract with Unified Supply, utilizing competitively awarded Broward County Contract No. OPN2118676B1, for baggage carousel replacement hardware parts. The new contract term will be March 1, 2021 to October 25, 2022, with a not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000.00, based upon historic spend data.

#### BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Engineering and Facilities Department has previously contracted wildlife services under the On-Call Environmental Consultant Services Contract; however, best practice suggests holding a separate contract for an on-call airport wildlife services consultant. The current On-Call Environmental Consultant Services Contract ends April 14, 2021. As such, Procurement issued Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 21-06-42001 for professional wildlife consulting services at each of JAA's four airports. ### BACKGROUND:

On or about March 23, 2020, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) approved Award No. AC2020-03-08 to Johnson Controls, Inc. (JCI) for maintenance of JAA's access control and video surveillance systems over a 12-month period ending in July 2021. JAA receives two invoices from JCI for these services, each covering a six-month period in advance.

As a result of an administrative oversight, an invoice for similar maintenance services that exceeded the authority of a prior award was applied to Award No. AC2020-03-08. If the administrative oversight is not ratified, the authority of Award No. AC2020-03-08 will also be exceeded.

### BACKGROUND:

JAA utilizes Johnson Controls owned software and hardware solutions for its access control and video surveillance systems. As these systems are critical to the operation of Jacksonville International Airport and other facilities, it is prudent to ensure that the systems are properly maintained and there is a mechanism in place for quick assistance if there is an issue disrupting system availability or usability. As such, JAA signed a service agreement to provide these services under GSA Schedule 84 Contract No. GS-07F-190CA (see Exhibit A for details).

### BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) utilizes Cisco WebEx for web meetings and video calls. WebEx is most compatible with JAA's computer environment.

WebEx services are offered on an annual, per-seat license basis, in addition to which JAA's IT Department recommends including a 10% contingency above the quoted annual price of \$20,924.64, as costs vary by license counts. The inclusion of contingency allows procurement of additional licenses, if necessary. Preventative maintenance services are available through Florida Cisco WSCA Contract No. AR233 4322000-WSCA-14-ACS, which will expire on May 31, 2021.

Inasmuch as this annual purchase was initially under JAA's formal threshold, it did not require JAA's Awards Committee consideration and approval. However, as of February 16, 2021, the total collective expenditure of \$18,185.34 will exceed JAA's \$25,000.00 formal threshold and, therefore, Awards Committee consideration and approval is required.
