BACKGROUND:

In November of 1993, the National Football League (NFL) awarded a team to the City of Jacksonville, which later became known as the Jacksonville Jaguars. The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has been a community partner since the inaugural season that began in September of 1995 and the JAA now enters its 29th year as a sponsor. The partnership: (i) centers around the sportsmanship of the game, which brings to Jacksonville thousands of fans who travel from the opposing team's city/state as well as those who live in the surrounding counties; and (ii) complies with Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Airport Compliance Manual, FAA Order No. 5190.6B, §15.9(b), designed to promote public awareness of JAA's facilities and services.

JAA continues to support the Jacksonville Jaguars as a corporate sponsor for the 2024 season at a cost of \$22,547.04. Further, JAA has committed to be a sponsor for a total of three years, 2024-2026, however, the exact cost of years 2025 and 2026 will not be known until the NFL releases ticket pricing in those years.

Pursuant to Section §2.05(A)(7) of JAA's Procurement Code, Procurement is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to continue this corporate sponsorship with the Jacksonville Jaguars. The 2025 season has an estimated cost of \$26,000.00 and the 2026 season has an estimated cost of \$29,000.00. These estimates are based on the previous five-year escalation incorporating an annual contingency of \$3,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

Executive Management recommends JAA make a properly noticed award, pursuant to §2.05(A)(7) of the Procurement Code, to the Jacksonville Jaguars, LLC, for a three-year corporate sponsorship consistent with FAA Order No. 5190.6B, §15.9(b), in a not-to-exceed amount of \$77,547.04, which includes an annual \$3,000.00 contingency.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has a continuing need to clearly understand the current dynamic air service challenges, define its value proposition, and promote use of its assets and services to all key stakeholders. Due to an expiring contract on June 30, 2024, Procurement released Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 24-08-11105 with the purpose of obtaining a marketing consultant firm with in-depth knowledge and expertise that can create, refine and/or develop advertising and promotional materials for JAA-managed assets and services on an "as-needed" basis. Potential services to be provided will include, but are not limited to:

- 1) Development of commercial caliber videos elements, such as script development, filming and editing for distribution digitally and on broadcast television; and
- 2) Assistance in executing a variety of airport marketing programs for air service, parking, concessions, customer service and the like.

On May 13, 2024, Procurement received and later ranked the following four proposals:

The evaluation committee unanimously recommended that an award be made to St. John & Partners Advertising and Public Relations, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$750,000.00, based upon Marketing's review of historical spending and the potential for new air service that may include international.

RECOMMENDATION:

Marketing recommends an award be made to St. John & Partners Advertising and Public Relations, the highest ranked of four respondents in response to RFQ No. 24-08-11105, for marketing consultant services, with an initial three-year term and renewal options of up to two years, for a total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$750,000.00, at JAA's sole discretion, based on vendor performance and adherence to contract terms and conditions, and approved budgeted funds. BACKGROUND:

Top Trumps is designing an official Jacksonville, Florida Edition of Monopoly which they plan to launch and offer for sale on or around February 2025. The game will be sold in stores including Barnes & Noble and Amazon as well as select local Jacksonville retailers.

Top Trumps, who licenses special editions of Monopoly from Hasbro, is currently seeking partners which would be featured on the game's board as well as in a Chance or Community Chest cards during play. The company approached the Jacksonville Aviation Authority about featuring the Jacksonville International Airport (JAX) in the game and, consistent with Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Airport Compliance Manual, FAA Order No. 5190.6B, §15.9(b), Marketing found the offer appealing as an opportunity to promote the Jax as one of the city's iconic locations.

Top Trumps offers three tiers of sponsorship packages: bronze, silver and gold. The Silver sponsorship package will allow Jax to have a space on the Jacksonville, FL edition of the Monopoly board and a Community Chest card in gameplay. The cost of the sponsorship is \$10,000 per year for a period of three years.

Other marketing and public relations benefits include: (i) JAX involvement in the product launch event, (ii) the iconic Monopoly guy visits the JAX terminal for photo/media opportunities, and (iii) JAA employees given opportunity to acquire the game at a wholesale price once available.

Pursuant to Section 3.09 of JAA's Procurement Code, Procurement has verified the proprietary license for development and creation and is of the opinion that it is in JAA's best interest to pursue this limited opportunity.

RECOMMENDATION:

Marketing recommends JAA make a properly noticed award, pursuant to Section 3.09 of JAA's Procurement Code, to Top Trumps USA, Inc., to feature the Jacksonville International Airport in the Jacksonville, Florida edition of Monopoly for three years, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$30,000.00.

BACKGROUND:

As part of the U.S. Navy's Base Realignment and Closure of Cecil Field in 1999, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) acquired a variety of Navy-built facilities. The more unique and mission specific facilities include jet engine test cells and jet engine "hush houses" which provide mounting and housing for the operation of jet engines in a controlled environment. These facilities include Engine Test Cells 334 and 339, Hush House 818, and Office Support Building 328. Under a prior lease agreement, JAA leased these facilities for engine and parts storage.

In conjunction with a growing spaceport industry and in an effort to lease these facilities for their intended purpose and highest use, Procurement issued Request for Interest No. 24-02-43101 in October of 2023, seeking an interested party to lease the facilities. On November 21, 2023, JAA received one conforming submittal from Hermeus Corporation ("Hermeus"). The submittal was evaluated and scored in alignment with Procurement's procedures, which resulted in a score of 94.00 out of 100 possible points.

Hermeus, an aerospace and defense technology company founded in 2018, owns and operates an engine test facility at DeKalb-Peachtree Airport. Hermeus expressed its intent to use all Cecil four facilities to develop future aerospace propulsion systems needed for reusable hypersonic vehicles for the Department of Defense.

RECOMMENDATION:

Business Development recommends an award be made to Hermeus Corporation, the sole respondent to RFI No. 24-02-43101, to lease Cecil Airport's Hush House 818, Engine Test Cells 334 and 339, and Office Support Building 328 for an initial term of five years with three five-year renewal options, and a projected initial rent of \$73,422.00 in the first lease year, subject to Board approval.

BACKGROUND:

On February 2, 2024, Engineering & Facilities released JAA-IFB-24-001M for the purchase of mitigation credits to offset wetland impacts associated with the Arnold Road Canal Project (the "Project"). JAA was granted an easement along the Arnold Road Canal to ensure adequate drainage is maintained at Jacksonville International Airport. This Project acquires wetland mitigation credits for maintenance activities in and around the canal to prevent flooding on the airfield.

On February 27, 2024, two proposals were received, the results of which are shown in the table below:

This Project has been on hold due to Florida Department of Environmental Protection permitting delays; however, Engineering & Facilities was notified in April of this year by Longleaf that credits could not be held due to market demand and some type of payment along with agreement commitment would be necessary to hold the proposal pricing. Upon Procurement and Legal review, an agreement and \$20,000.00 deposit were negotiated. Exhibit "B" was executed and PO No. 58973 was provided to secure this purchase.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends an award be made to Roberts Land & Timber Investment Corp *dba* Longleaf Mitigation Development Company, LLC, the lower of two responsive, responsible bidders in response to JAA-IFB-24-001M, for the purchase of federal mitigation credits for JAA's Arnold Road Canal Project, in the total not-to-exceed amount of \$186,750.00.

BACKGROUND:

In September 2021, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) approved JAA Award No. AC2021-09-16 to RS&H Inc., Landrum and Brown, Inc and Ricondo & Associates, Inc. for on-call engineering planning services. All three firms were awarded \$500,000.00 for asneeded services.

Based on spend analysis, Landrum and Brown, Inc. costs for services have exceeded the approved spending authority from the previous award and require a ratification of \$8,973.00 for services awarded in June 2024. Therefore, it is anticipated that an additional \$175,000.00 will be necessary to handle any further requisitions through September 30, 2025, which is contract expiration.

Furthermore, Ricondo & Associates, Inc. will soon exceed the \$500,000.00 approved spending authority from the previous award. Therefore, it is anticipated that an additional \$175,000.00 will be necessary to handle any further requisitions through September 30, 2025, which, again, is contract expiration.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA Award No. AC2021-09-16, for planning on-call services, be amended to: (i) ratify the amount of \$8,973.00 as awarded to Landrum and Brown; and (ii) increase the amount awarded to Landrum and Brown and Ricondo & Associates by \$175,000.00 each through contract expiration of September 30, 2025.

Jacksonville International Airport (Jax) currently has a full Federal Inspection Services (FIS) facility located on Concourse C below the Gate C5 area. Gate C5 is a "swing gate" and can accommodate domestic or international flights. While Jax has limited commercial international flights that need this gate, it is also used by international General Aviation (GA) flights. However, JAA will have an increasing need to use Gate C5 as a domestic gate when the construction is completed on Concourse B. BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has a continuing need for Security Access Control and Video Preventative Maintenance, CCure 9000, and Victor Video Surveillance.
