WHEREAS, on or about May 4, 2022, based on mutual needs of the Parties, the Authority and Contractor amended the scope to include additional services for the Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT) located at Cecil Airport pursuant to Amendment No. 2;

WHEREAS, on or about February 13, 2024, based on the mutual needs of the Parties, the Authority and Contractor amended the scope to include additional services for Hangar 1005 Pump House located at Cecil Airport pursuant to Amendment No. 3;

WHEREAS, on or about March 12, 2025, based on the mutual needs of the Parties, the Authority and Contractor further amended the scope to include additional services Buildings 67, 312, 825, 1820 and 1823 located at Cecil Airport pursuant to Amendment No. 4 and;

WHEREAS, based on the operational needs of the Authority, the Authority and Contractor desire to further amend the agreement to remove wet and dry fire protection systems services for the United States Coast Guard (USCG) Hangar 13 located at Cecil Airport.
