**This Amendment No. 1** is made and entered into in duplicate this 11<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2023, by and between the Jacksonville Aviation Authority, a Florida public body politic and corporate whose address is 14201 Pecan Park Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32218 (the “Authority”) and Interstate Restoration, LLC d/b/a First Onsite Property Restoration (“Contractor”), a corporation authorized to do business with the state of Florida, regarding the Agreement by and between the Parties dated April 11, 2023, for On-call Emergency, Disaster, and Biohazard Clean-up and Restoration Services (“Agreement”).

*RECITALS*

**WHEREAS**, on or about April 11, 2023, the Authority entered into an Agreement for Services with the Contractor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement contains a provision that, at the sole discretion of the Authority, permits the Parties to renew the Agreement at the prices, rates, fees, percentages, or discounts contained in the Agreement;

**WHEREAS**, based on a scrivener’s omission, the Authority and Contractor desire to amend the Agreement to include additional supplies, equipment and personnel as required for Hazmat / Biological Services.

**NOW THEREFORE**, THE PARTIES, BASED UPON MUTUAL CONSIDERATION, THE SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH IS ACKNOWLEDGED, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **INCORPORATION OF RECITALS.** The Parties find that the statements set forth in the above recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporate the same as part of this amendment.

2. **SCOPE / CHANGE IN SERVICES.** The Parties agree to include additional supplies, equipment and personnel as required for Hazmat / Biological Services. This is a requirements contract under which Contractor will not perform any work until such time as the Authority identifies a need, requests and approves in writing a proposal from Contractor for the same.




