This Amendment No. 4 is made and entered into in duplicate this 22nd day of May, 2025, by and between the Jacksonville Aviation Authority, a Florida public body politic and corporate whose address is 14201 Pecan Park Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32218 (the “Authority”) and Fire Sprinkler Services FL, LLC (“Contractor”), a limited liability company authorized to do business with the state of Florida, regarding the Agreement by and between the Parties dated March 24, 2023, for Fire Protection Panels Alarm and Monitoring, Preventative Maintenance and Repair Services (“Agreement”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about March 24, 2023, the Authority entered into an Agreement for Services with the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contains a provision that, at the sole discretion of the Authority, permits the Parties to renew the Agreement at the prices, rates, fees, percentages, or discounts contained in the Agreement;

WHEREAS, on or about January 24, 2024, the Parties amended the Agreement to switch monitoring services for Pump Houses 594 and 595 located at Cecil Airport from phone line monitoring to cell monitoring pursuant to Amendment No. 1;

WHEREAS, on or about October 28, 2024, the Parties amended the Agreement to include a) monitoring services for Cecil Spaceport Hangar; and b) switched monitoring services for Building 1846 from phone line monitoring to cell monitoring pursuant to Amendment No. 2;

WHEREAS, on or about February 21, 2025, the Authority and Contractor further amended the Agreement as follows: a) include cell monitoring services for Cecil Airport Buildings 67, 312, 825, 1820 and 1823; and b) switch monitoring services for Buildings 1826 and 1847 from phone line monitoring to cell monitoring pursuant to Amendment No. 3 and;

WHEREAS, based on the operational needs of the Authority, the Authority and Contractor desire to further amend the agreement to remove fire protection panels alarm and monitoring, preventative maintenance and repair services for the United States Coast Guard (USCG) Hangar 13 located at Cecil Airport.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES, BASED UPON MUTUAL CONSIDERATION, THE SUFFICIENCY OF WHICH IS ACKNOWLEDGED, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:
