Tree Trimming and Tree Removal Services**

Questions

Q1. Do you have any estimated quantities for year one? # of trees for take down, number of trees requiring trimming

R1. For Jacksonville International Airport, estimated quantities include, but are not limited to, trimming 500 palm trees, 150 oak trees and some pine trees. The number of trees to be taken down will vary.

For Herlong, Cecil Airport and Jacksonville Executive Airport, there is no quantity estimate as services will be on an as needed basis to include but not limited to palm trees, oak trees, and pine trees.

Q2. Do you have any size estimates for the trees to be taken down? (DBH sizing?)

R2. No. The size will vary for each location and each service. See R5.

Q3. How often (in the past) have you used the emergency call out services?

R3. No airport locations have utilized the emergency call out service in the past.

Q4. What is the timeframe to complete the work once it's been assigned? (are there different periods for trims vs. take down?)

R4. This will vary per location and per service. There are currently no set time periods. Palm tree trimming generally takes place before the berries form on the trees.

Q5. How can we give a bid price when there are no sizes in the scope of work. Are we bidding on the diameter of the trees or total sizes of the trees?

R5. The scope of work does not specify tree sizes; therefore, bidders will provide a single, all-inclusive cost per tree. The unit price submitted shall apply to each tree serviced, regardless of size or diameter.
