## BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Engineering & Facilities Department requires on-call backflow repair services to support JAA's four airports for repairs necessary after required inspections of its backflow preventers. JAA previously contracted these services utilizing a "piggyback" contract; however, that option is no longer available.

On February 13, 2023, Procurement released Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 23-08-45123, Backflow Repair Services, and received no bids. The scope of work was revised and was rebid on March 21, 2023. On March 29, 2023, two bids were received from: (i) Dolphin Backflow; and (ii) A-Plus Environmental Solutions. Based on the hourly rates received, an award was recommended for A-Plus Environmental Solutions, the responsive, responsible bidder, providing the lower hourly rate for "as-needed" services.

### **RECOMMENDATION**:

Engineering & Facilities recommends a requirements award be made to A-Plus Environmental Solutions, the lower of two bidders in responses to ITB No. 23-08-45123, for Backflow Repair Services, in a total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000.00, for use on an "as-needed" basis for an initial three-year term and renewals of up to two additional years at JAA's sole discretion, based on annually approved budgeted funds, vendor performance, and adherence to all terms and conditions of the contract documents. Funds are budgeted within various cost centers.

In order to complete the modernization project for Elevators 17 and 18 and to allow Procurement time to resolicit this scope, Engineering & Facilities desires a contract extension through December 31, 2023, or until a new contract solicitation, award and execution is completed, which extension would result in an increase of \$198,328.00.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

### BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) owns and operates a four-Airport System consisting of Jacksonville International Airport (JAX), Jacksonville Executive at Craig Airport (JAXEX), Herlong Recreational Airport (HEG) and Cecil Airport and Spaceport (VQQ). JAA has established a Title VI Plan in accordance with USDOT/FAA 49 CFR Part 21 rules and requirements to receive federal funding for its four-airport system. The Title VI plan was last updated and audited in 2015 and requires a comprehensive review. The USDOT/FAA has newly established guidelines that require a Community Participation Plan to define how JAA will adequately inform the public about programs and activities that will have potential impact on JAA's surrounding communities. The FAA's tentative schedule for Title VI and Community Participation Plan program reviews for medium hub airports is FY2023/FY2024.

In accordance with Article 2.02 of RFP No. 21-35-26201, the Procurement Department reached out to Ken Weeden and Associates, Inc. (KWA) and requested a proposal for Title VI and Community Participation Plan consulting services. KWA is very familiar with USDOT/FAA DBE, ACDBE, Title VI and CPP Program (49 CFR 26, 21) requirements and has worked with various airports to develop and maintain these plans. Therefore, Procurement has determined that it is in JAA's best interest to amend its contract with KWA to include this award.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Procurement recommends JAA Award No. AC2021-09-04, awarded to Ken Weeden and Associates, Inc., for DBE / ACDBE Consulting Services, be amended to: (i) provide services related to Title VI revisions and the creation of a Community Participation Plan; and (ii) increase the award by \$22,250.00, for a new total potential award amount of \$80,610.00. ## BACKGROUND:

On June 22, 2020, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2020-06-07 to IRIS Ltd, Inc. for access control supplies. The award authorized a contract for supplies through December 31, 2024, in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$170,000.00.

## **BACKGROUND**:

The 2023 Herlong Recreational Airport fuel farm inspection resulted in two findings that require corrective action. First, NFPA 407 requires the fuel loading rack to be equipped with an automatic shutdown system, known as a Skully System that stops the tank loading operation when the fuel servicing vehicle tank is full. All farms must comply with this system and be fully functional by June 2, 2023.

Second, NFPA 407 requires above ground storage tanks have a fusible device that causes each outlet valve to close automatically in case of fire. These upgrades will enhance the safety of fuel loading procedures at the airport and bring JAA into compliance with NFPA 407 standards for aircraft fuel servicing.

On March 31, 2023, Procurement issued Invitation to Bid No. 23-15-44402 (ITB) for Fuel Farm Upgrades for Herlong Airport. No bids were received on April 14, 2023, despite notice on JAA's website and in the Jacksonville Daily Record, as well as notice being transmitted to 106 companies, of which 12 downloaded bid documents on the DemandStar platform.

Procurement completed its due diligence in attempting to competitively solicit these services and is of the opinion that a re-solicitation would produce similar results and delay the timeline to comply with NFPA deadline. Procurement contacted Gibson Aviation Services as a result of research conducted by Herlong Airport. Pursuant to Section 3.02(G) of JAA's Procurement Code, Procurement requested Gibson to review and submit pricing for the scope of work. Gibson agreed to fill out JAA's bid form and to abide by the terms and conditions of the ITB.

### BACKGROUND:

This project includes modification of Economy Parking Lot 3 located at Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). The existing 16-acre gravel parking lot will be replaced with a new, paved asphalt parking lot totaling 1,160 parking spaces. The parking lot construction includes concrete entrance drives, asphalt pavement, traffic signage, pavement striping, bus shelters, stormwater facilities, gate access control equipment, security cameras, lighting, electrical vehicle charging stations, landscaping, and irrigation.

Three (3) responsive bids were received on April 4, 2023.

It is not uncommon for construction bids to exceed Engineer's estimates during this period of extreme activity in the construction industry and persistent material shortages. There is currently \$1,645,157.39 remaining in the project budget.

#### BACKGROUND:

This project will remove and mitigate wetland areas, eliminate low areas of standing water, construct ditches and culverts to maintain proper drainage within the Runway 26 approach at Jacksonville International Airport. Wetlands within the project area have been identified in Wildlife Hazard Assessments (WHAs) as potential wildlife attractants for a myriad of bird species, and their removal has been recommended as a high priority. #### BACKGROUND:

The East Ramp gate is one of Herlong Recreational Airport's most heavily used vehicle gates and has been in service for over 20 years. The West Access Road gate provides direct access to the AOA, but it is in a remote area of Herlong's property and has no access control monitoring equipment, which makes it difficult to ensure security. This purchase will replace both systems with a more efficient Hy-Security Slide Driver gate operator and aluminum double trolley gate. They will also be connected to the CCure access control system so staff can monitor alarms, operate the gate remotely, and perform access control audits.

On April 19, 2023, Procurement released Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 23-17-44402. On May 10, 2023, Procurement received proposals from the following companies: (i) Vigneaux Corp; (ii) Armstrong Fence Co; (iii) SWi, LLC; and (iv) Guardian Fence and Gates, LLC.

Upon review of the requirement documents, three of the four companies were ruled nonconforming for failure to provide Mandatory Respondent Criteria as required by Section 1.09 of the ITB and, therefore, Vigneaux Corp was the sole responsible, responsive bidder.

#### BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) is taking steps to prepare Cecil Airport land east of Taxiway E and south of Wing Lane for future development. Building 59 is located on the future development site and houses electrical equipment, including an emergency generator that supports the Instrument Landing System Localizer, Precision Approach Path Indicators and Runway End Identifier Lights. This project will relocate these required services west of Taxiway E.

JAA, in conjunction with Suncoast Industrial, Inc., has completed a review and assessment of the work required to relocate Building 59 services.
