BACKGROUND:

On October 23, 2023, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2023-10-16 to Bozard Ford Lincoln for the purchase of two 2024 Ford F-150 4x4 Responder Crew Cab Pickup Trucks for the JAA Police Department (JAAPD). The award authorized funding for trucks with limited accessories and outfitting. The two trucks have arrived, and Fleet and JAAPD Management have determined additional operational accessories are needed. This includes, but is not limited to, lighting packages and K-9 storage system.

Pursuant to Sections 2.05(A)(12) and/or 3.08 of JAA's Procurement Code, Procurement's review of Bradford County Sheriffs' Association Contract No. BCSO 22-27-1.0 reveal that it remains favorable and continues to meet JAA's needs for such purchases. As such, Procurement is of the opinion that it is still in JAA's best interest to continue piggybacking this contract, which was competitively awarded to Bozard Ford Lincoln.

Bozard Ford Lincoln has prepared a quote for the additional accessories and outfitting in the amount of \$51,549.20. Additionally, Engineering & Facilities would like to request an additional amount of \$3,450.80 to cover any unforeseen costs.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA Award No. AC2023-10-16 to Bozard Ford Lincoln, for two 2024 Ford F-150 4x4 Responder Crew Cab Pickup Trucks and limited accessories and outfitting, be amended to increase awarded funding by \$55,000.00, for additional truck accessories and outfitting, resulting in a new total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$185,000.00.

BACKGROUND:

In May of 2022, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2022-05-10 to SICK, Inc., for a hold baggage system (HBS) Scanner Array System Upgrade and Annual Maintenance Agreement. Engineering & Facilities is requesting approval to add services to the annual maintenance agreement.

More specifically, the desired additional services include two annual site visits to assess the Jacksonville International Airport's Baggage Handling System. These site visits will provide guidance and a system software assessment of the current baggage scanning arrays. SICK, Inc. is the sole source manufacturer of the previously installed six-head scanner array and controllers. Furthermore, Engineering & Facilities anticipate an additional \$15,000.00 to cover unforeseen costs that may result from the site assessments through contract expiration.

RECOMMENDATION:

Engineering & Facilities recommends JAA Award No. AC2022-05-10 to SICK, Inc., for an HBS Scanner Array System Upgrade and Annual Maintenance Agreement, be amended to: (i) increase awarded funding by \$24,476.00, for two annual preventative maintenance site visits; and (ii) include an additional \$15,000.00 for any unforeseen costs, resulting in a new total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$206,714.00. Funds are budgeted within 45133.77420.

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) has a need for maintenance, repair and operating (MRO) supplies, equipment, and related products for use throughout its Airport System. Lowes Home Centers, LLC (Lowes) has a proven track record of providing these items at a discount, with multiple locations in close proximity to airports and timely customer service.

Lowes was competitively awarded Omnia Partners Contract No. R240805, which is a cooperative public purchasing agreement. The contract includes MRO supplies, equipment and related products and services for a term through October 31, 2027, with two one-year renewal options. More specifically, the referenced contract offers percentage discounts across various categories of MRO materials, in addition to annual rebates for qualifying purchases.

Pursuant to Sections 2.05(A)(12) and/or 3.08 of the Procurement Code, Procurement has reviewed Omnia Partners Contract No. R240805, for MRO supplies and related services, which offers current and favorable pricing. As such, Procurement is of the opinion it is in JAA's best interest to procure these supplies and services by utilizing or piggybacking this contract, which, again, was competitively awarded to Lowes.

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

The Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) purchases and stocks needed supplies for the Hold Baggage System (HBS), such as belts, rollers, and pulleys among other necessary items that are critical for airport operations.

On December 6, 2024, Procurement issued ITB No. 25-09-17111 for HBS belts, rollers and pulleys, to solicit necessary parts for an efficient operating system. Bids were opened on January 8, 2025, and one responsive bid was received from Belt Power, LLC.

Based on historic spend, wear and tear, future growth and unit pricing over a potential fiveyear term, Procurement and Facilities estimate the need for this commodity of \$168,000.00 per contract year. This estimate is supported by anticipation of an increase in passenger traffic, airport expansion, and inventory needs to maintain critical operations.

RECOMMENDATION:

Procurement recommends that JAA make an award to Belt Power LLC, the sole responsive and responsible bidder in response to ITB No. 25-09-17111, for hold baggage system belts, rollers, pulleys and related items, in a total potential not-to-exceed amount of \$840,000.00 over the five-year contract term.

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) Title 49 Part 1542 and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Security Directive 1542-04-08 series, Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) applicants are required to undergo fingerprint-based criminal history records check (CHRC) and have an approved Security Threat Assessment (STA) before receiving a badge and obtaining unescorted access to secured airport areas. The regulation and security directive requires the use of a TSA approved Designated Aviation Channeler to meet the established standards.

On October 14, 2024, JAA released RFP No. 25-03-46104 for a designated aviation channeling service provider. Procurement received one conforming proposal from the incumbent, Telos Identity Management Solutions, LLC, and Procurement's Director approved proceeding without further solicitation. The proposal was evaluated, resulting in a score of 89.89 out of 100 possible points.

The award amount is based on rates outlined below for a Criminal History Records Check (CHRC), Security Threat Assessment (STA) and TSA FBI – Rap Back Subscription (JAA currently averages approximately 769.83 applicants per month). The estimate of \$600,000.00 for a ten-year term is also supported by an anticipated increase in staffing levels with the airport expansion.

BACKGROUND:

On January 22, 2024, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority's (JAA) Awards Committee approved JAA Award No. AC2024-01-09 to amend approved JAA Award No. AC2021-09-20. These awards were to the City of Jacksonville (COJ) for the use of the First Coast Radio System for JAA's Police and Operations communications with other city agencies such as Jacksonville Fire and Rescue and the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. The award authorized funding for services for FY24 in a total not-to-exceed amount of \$126,285.12. Information Technology recommends the award include an additional three radios to provide flexibility as we do hardware refresh this year, for an additional annual cost of \$951.48 and a total potential award amount of \$38,059.20.

It should be noted that changing the quantity of radios on the system or changes to future rates will affect the amount JAA is required to pay.
